How to apply for financial help from NewstrAid

If you are applying to NewstrAid for support, it is likely that you are going through a challenging time. With this in mind we have done our best to make the process as easy as possible.

In most cases, we ask that applicants use the application platform provided by our trusted partner, Lightning Reach, which uses secure technology to make it as quick and safe as possible for you.

Scottish Curry Night

Support for children and dependants

Following the death of her husband from cancer, Priya was left to care for their teenage daughter on her own, whilst struggling with her own poor health. Her daughter had recently been diagnosed with scoliosis and had been advised that she would need major surgery within a year. On top of this she was in the middle of doing her A-levels and the worries of both were making her quite stressed. The family had discussed a holiday which they felt would be beneficial but needed some financial help to make it possible.

Priya was already in receipt of regular benefit from NewstrAid to help support everyday living costs but due to the family's current circumstances she was awarded an additional one-off grant of £250 to help fund a trip with her daughter.

Support during illness

Kim had worked in shops selling newspapers and magazines for 5 years but due to ill health was unable to work full-time and was struggling financially and finding it difficult to cope. She applied for help from NewstrAid via Lightning Reach.

In the first instance she was put in touch with the Debt Advice Foundation to help manage her finances and was given details of the resources available on our Wellbeing Website to support her mental health. Her application was then considered by the Welfare Committee and following a financial review, she was given a Cost of Living Crisis Fund grant and a one-off grant to clear her rent and energy bill arears. In addition, because of her long-term financial situation, the committee agreed she should become a regular beneficiary to receive ongoing support to meet her living costs.



Advice only

Nadeem had owned an off licence that sells newspapers and magazines for 12 years and contacted NewstrAid because his business was struggling.

Unfortunately, NewstrAid cannot help with any business related problems. As he had no concerns at home the team advised him to contact Business Debtline for further help and gave him details of NewstrAid's Wellbeing Website to find resources that might help look after his mental health during this stressful time.
